Knox Centre for Ministry and Leadership invites ministry leaders and practitioners to join in an action experimenting course in local mission. This builds on listening work done in your local community.

The course helps leaders engage a team in discerning places and networks where God possibilities might emerge and action an experiment to test this discernment. Skills and frameworks for recognising possibilities, discerning a Christ patterned opportunity for mission innovation, designing and implementing an experiment are explored. Peer mentoring and coaching provides support and wisdom.

Course participants will commit to 4 online webinars following the first introductory one. Outside the webinars they will recruit and lead a small team in their own ministry context in meeting to learn, design, and implement a small mission action experiment. You will be guided by the steps, resources and tools offered in the webinar. Together with other participants and KMCL tutors we will listen to scripture, integrate tools and frameworks, clarify expectations, share learnings and celebrate progress.

Mission Action Experimenting builds on prior community listening. Participants will need to complete a summary community listening exercise before beginning the 2nd webinar. Further information will be supplied so if you have not engaged in structured community listening.

As a parish we spent time going through the mission plan process... To seek out where God might already be at work in the community and join God in that work were the words that kept coming through. It all sounded great but how did you put legs on that?

The KCML listening in mission course was the first step in this process. We then went on with the next course experimenting in mission. We have been surprised at the work of the Spirit in and through this... They gave structure, guidance, with strong theological underpinning. They also gave companionship and collegiately with others struggling along the same road while all the time encouraging us to move out and experiment, trusting that God is at work in the world.
